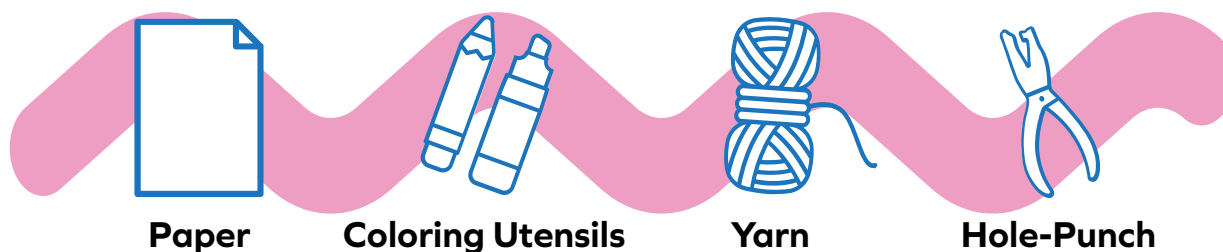


# My Classroom Culture Quilt

Get other classrooms involved in the fun and create a school-wide quilt.



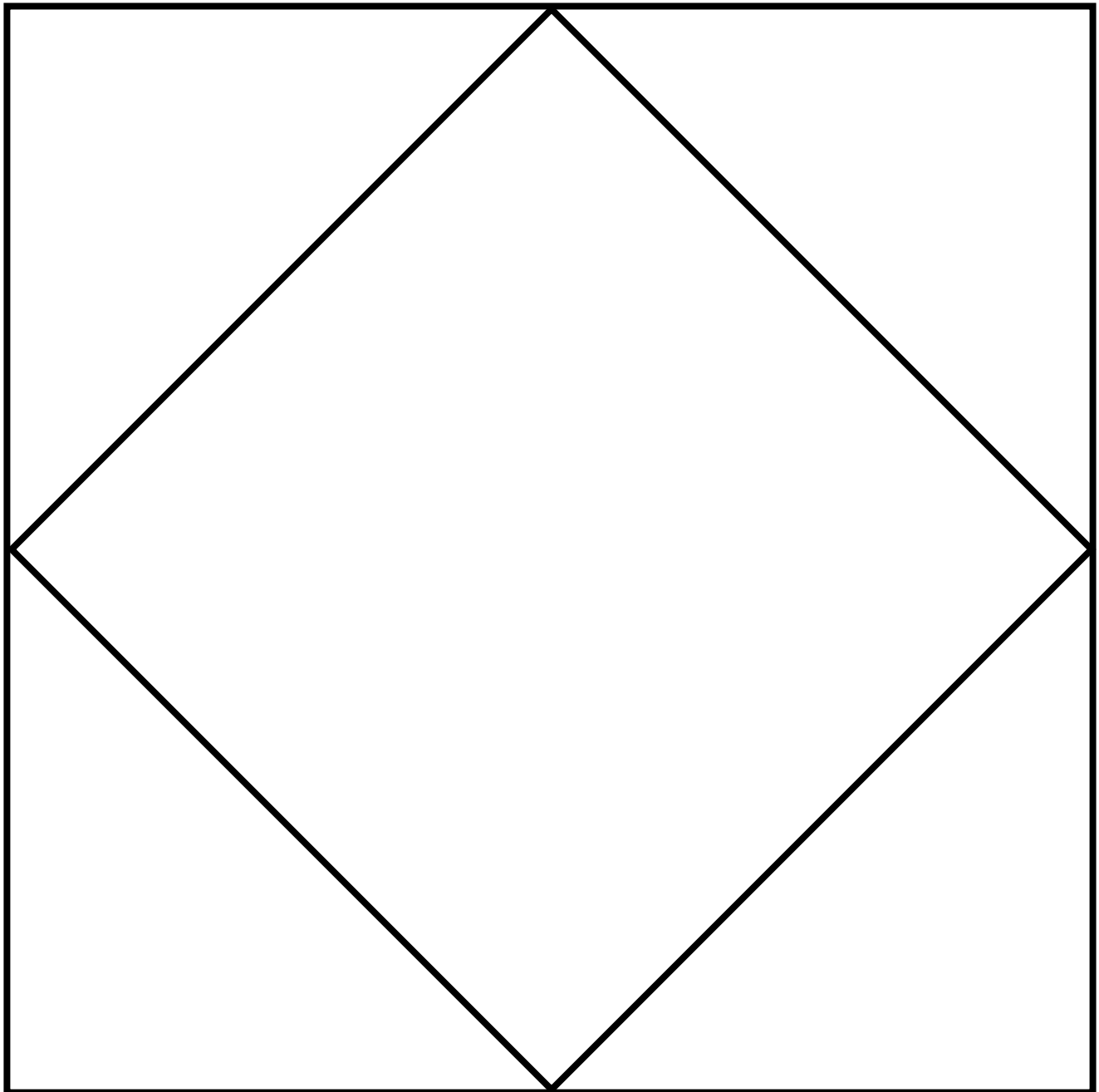
