

# Digital Responsibility Shield Activity

Grades 3-5

## **For the Teacher**

This activity is to help students understand their online identity and to reinforce behaviors that reflect digital responsibility. Students will create and share a digital identity shield with classmates or family members.

Read the [digital responsibility article](#) as an opportunity to discuss this with students before they engage in this activity. Use the [ILS Maître d'](#) to lead a class discussion using the sample questions below to brainstorm ideas before starting the activity.

- What are some important things about digital responsibility you want to remember?
- How can you be a good digital citizen?

**Materials:** Digital shield template, optional; colored pencils or markers

**Extension:** Based on what the students share, create a class Digital Rules Poster to remind students how to be responsible digital citizens.



# Digital Shield Template

**Directions:** Divide your shield into four sections and write about the following:

1. **Who I am:** Draw symbols and write words that represent your values.
2. **Online Actions:** List ways you will be respectful online (being kind to others, not spreading rumors, etc.)
3. **Online Safety:** Draw symbols to represent staying safe online (keeping passwords safe, avoiding strangers, etc.)
4. **Other:** Draw or share other ways to be a responsible digital citizen.
