

Digital Hero Activity

Grades K-2

For the Teacher

This activity allows students to design a digital hero character who shows digital responsibility. Open this activity by discussing and creating a list of ways to be a responsible digital citizen on chart paper. You can make a “digital hero badge” to celebrate students who show digital responsibility each week. At the end of the session, students will be allowed to share their heroes and digital powers with the class.

Review the [digital responsibility article](#) before starting this activity.

Give each child the digital hero template or blank paper to create their hero. A few examples could be:

- A superhero who keeps your password safe
- A gadget used to remind you to be kind online

Remind the students to give their hero a cool name with special digital powers.

Materials: Chart paper, blank paper or digital hero template, crayons, markers, or colored pencils

Classroom Extension Idea: Show students your digital hero badge and allow them to design their own. These badges can be used for the weekly digital hero to wear in the classroom. Students can vote or nominate a hero each week, or the teacher can select them.
